# Things to Do

## Talcott Mountain State Park & Heublein Tower

Rte. 185, Simsbury, CT  
Hike the 1.25 mile, 30-40 min. Tower Trail of Talcott Mountain State Park to reach the 165-foot tower.  
\*\*The museum is open Thursday through Monday from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend.

## West Hartford Reservoir #6

3070 Albany Ave, West Hartford, CT 06117  
West Hartford Reservoir #6 Trail is a 3.8 mile moderately trafficked loop trail located near Avon, Connecticut that features a lake and is good for all skill levels. Best used from March until October. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.

## MARK TWAIN HOUSE

351 Farmington Ave, Hartford, CT 06105  
The Mark Twain House & Museum has restored the author's Hartford, Connecticut, home, where the author and his family lived from 1874 to 1891. Twain wrote his most important works during the years he lived there.

## Hill-Stead Museum

35 Mountain Rd, Farmington, CT 06032  
The Hill-Stead Museum is a Colonial Revival house and art museum set on a large estate in Farmington, Connecticut. It is best known for its French Impressionist masterpieces, architecture, and stately grounds.
